

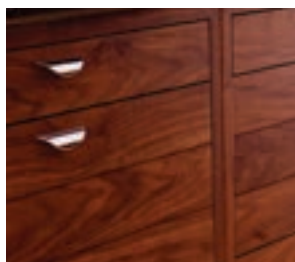

Prooftint is a unique, spirit-based stain that allows the full clarity of the timber grain to show through after staining.

Use undiluted to achieve deep, rich colour or dilute with Prooftint Colour Reducer to achieve lighter shades. Prooftint colours can be mixed together to achieve an exact colour match for your timber.

Prooftint can also be added to Feast Watson Clear Varnish, creating a one-step stain and varnish.

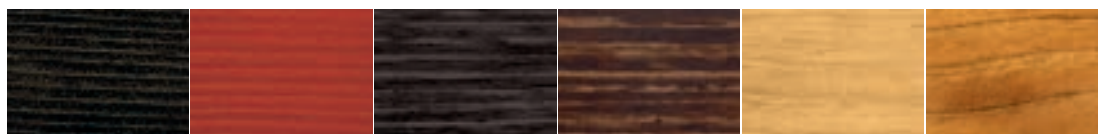

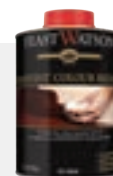

Prooftint Colour Reducer

When staining larger projects and floors, dilute Prooftint with Prooftint Colour Reducer to allow more time to evenly distribute the stain and achieve a uniform appearance.

STAIN & VARNISH



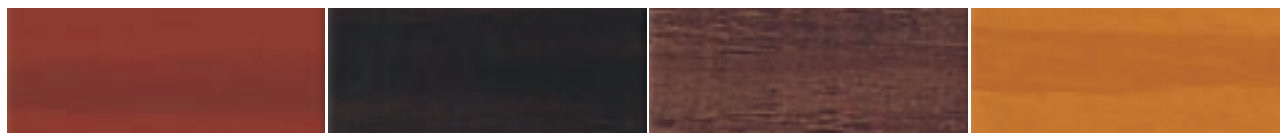
A rich interior timber stain blended with premium varnish for one-step colour and protection, without obscuring the natural characteristics of the timber grain.

Three coats of varnish are required. If the desired colour is achieved with the first coat, complete the following coats with Feast Watson Clear Varnish as additional coats of Stain & Varnish will intensify the colour.

Stain & Varnish is available in gloss or satin.

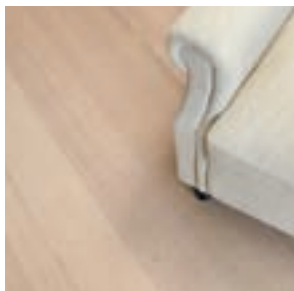

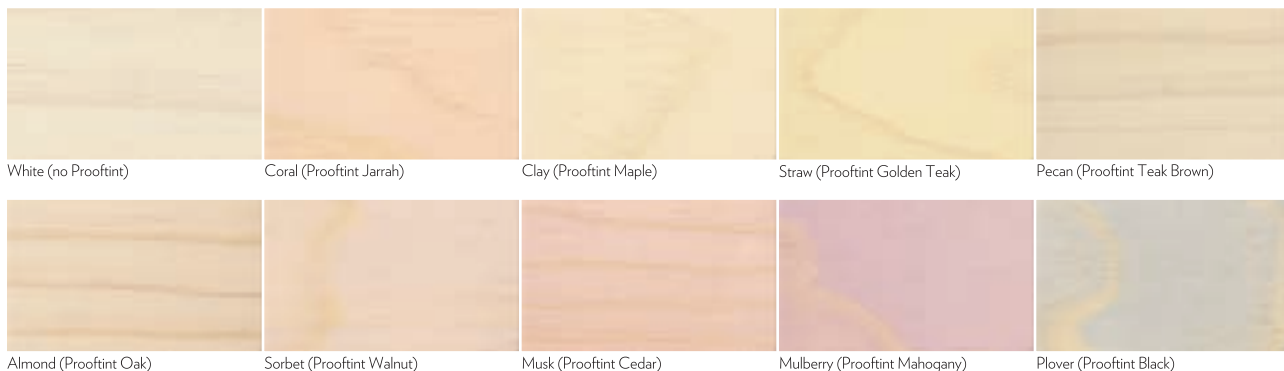
LIMING WHITE STAIN



A soft, light, solvent based stain that transforms your interior timber without hiding the beauty of the natural grain.

Tint using Feast Watson Proofint to achieve the unique timber colour of your dreams.

Liming Stain must be top coated with a Feast Watson interior clear such as Feast Watson Timber Floor Varnish or Feast Watson Scandinavian Oil.

STAIN & VARNISH LIMING WHITE



Stain & Varnish Liming white gives a soft, milky white effect to timber and simultaneously preserves the stain by protecting it with a clear finish.

Apply one coat for a subtle, pale colour or multiple coats to build the opacity and whiteness.

For interior floors, apply Feast Watson Timber Floor Varnish as per the label instructions. For all other interior timber (not floors) apply three coats of Feast Watson Clear Varnish as per label directions.

Available in gloss and satin.

LIMING WHITE TIMBER FLOOR STAIN & VARNISH



Liming White Timber Floor Stain & Varnish gives a soft, milky white effect to timber and simultaneously preserves the stain by protecting it with a clear finish.

The water based formula imparts colour without obscuring the natural characteristic of the timber grain. It is convenient to apply and all application equipment can be cleaned up with water.

For Liming White Timber Floor Stain & Varnish apply one coat for a subtle, pale colour or multiple to build up the opacity and whiteness.

*Liming White Timber Floor Stain & Varnish is a three coat flooring system. If the desired colour is achieved in less than three coats, complete the system with a suitable water based clear floor coating. Colours can be tested using Feast Watson Stain & Varnish Liming White 250ml sample pots. All colours tinted in store. Samples shown on Victorian Ash. Tinted samples show 3 coats.

TIMBER FLOOR PAINT



Timber Floor Paint is an opaque, water-based coating for adding colour to interior timber floors. It has been specially formulated to provide superior mark resistance and deliver outstanding adhesion and wear resistance for longer lasting results.

It is available in White and Ultra Deep Base and can be tinted to a wide range of colours.

Note: Timber Floor Paint provides a satin finish. For a glossy finish, we recommend Cabot's CFP and follow as per label instructions.

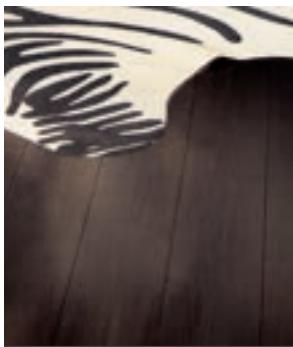


Get creative

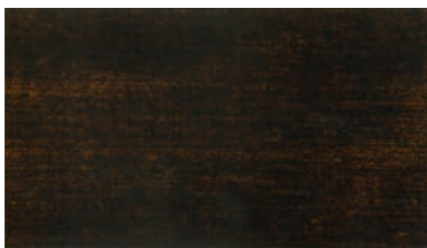
BLACK JAPAN TIMBER FLOOR STAIN & VARNISH

With each coat applied, you'll achieve a stronger Black Japan colour. Keep some of the timber grain or create an intense, black finish.

Black Japan Floor Finish is a three coat flooring system. If the desired colour is achieved in less than three coats, complete the system with Feast Watson Timber Floor Varnish.

TRADITIONAL TIMBER OIL



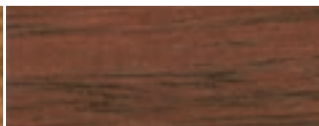
Traditional Timber Oil is a penetrating oil for a classic finish on decking and exterior timber.

It has added eucalyptus oil and is a rich natural colour which can be tinted to highlight the character of timber species.



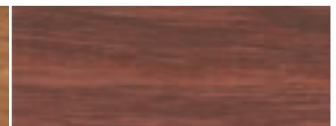

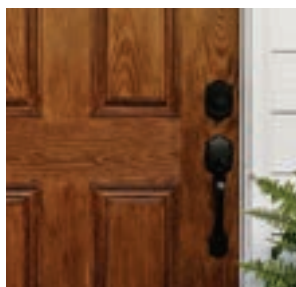
UV Protection
